- iii) Bid Security and Tender Document Fee shall be in the form of Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque drawan in favour of "Rajasthan State Mines & Minerals Limited" payable at Udaipur and shall be submitted to the office of the GGM(MM), 4-Meera Marg, Udaipur upto schedule date and time as above.

- iv) **Processing Fee** shall be in the form of Demand Draft / Banker Cheque drawan in favour of " **MD RISL**" **payable at Jaipur** and shall also be submitted to the office of the GGM(MM), 4-Meera Marg, Udaipur upto schedule date and time, as above
- v) Conditional tenders and casual letters sent by the bidders will not be accepted.
- vi) Bidders are requested to read the instruction in the Tender Document/Bid before submitting the Tender/BID online.

2.0 SUBMISSION & OPENING OF TENDERS:

The online submission of bids on the e-procurement portal i.e. http://eproc.rajasthan.gov.in within the specified date and time will be the

sole responsibility of the Tenderers. In case the date of opening of bids happens to be a holiday, then the bids shall be opened on the next working day.

Tenderers are requested to ensure submitting their tender online on e-procurement portal only and furnishing Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque/Bank Pay Orders towards tender document fee/Bid Security/Processing Fees offline to the office of GGM(MM) within the specified time & date of submission. Tenders in physical form (offline) will not be acceptable in any case.

Tenderers may note that they will not be able to submit their tenders online after the specified/ scheduled date & time of submission of bid document. Tenderers should also to ensure furnishing Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Bank Pay Orders towards tender document fee/Bid Security/ Processing Fees to the office of GGM(MM) within the specified time & date of submission. Failing which, their online bids will not be opened.

3.0 SPECIFICATIONS & QUANTITY: The specifications of existing set-up and technical details of required one no. Vertical Turbine Pump with Motor Assy. are as per Annexure-VI. Tenderer is requested to give point wise confirmation of specifications.

4.0 PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

- (i) The bidder should be manufacturer or its authorized dealer / distributor of offered pump. In case of authorized dealers/distributors, furnish the authorization certificate of OEM in tenderer's favour.
- (ii) Bidder/ OEM must have supplied equivalent or higher capacity vertical turbine pump to end user party. Please furnish Purchase Order / performance certificate copies etc in support of execution of work in past and details of same are to be mentioned at Annexure-VIII.
- (iii) Bidder will provide confirmation in Annexure-VI,b to provide laboratories for testing (Either In-house or third party):-
 - (a) The expected field performance of the pump may be obtained by testing the bowl assembly in the laboratory and then calculating the required performance.
 - (b) As far as possible, full load and full speed tests shall be conducted.

5.0 VALIDITY:

The tenderer shall keep the offer open for acceptance by RSMML for a minimum period of **Four months** from the date of opening of tender (Part-I), within which period the tenderer shall have no right to withdraw, cancel, amend or modify his offer. In case of withdrawal/cancellation/ amendment/ modification in the offered tender, the Bid Security deposited by the tenderer shall stand forfeited. The validity period may be extended further, if required, by mutual consent from time to time.

In case, tenderer, after issuance of communication of acceptance of offer (LOA/PO) by RSMML, fails to execute the contract as per the conditions therein,

such an event will be considered as the tenderer's calculated willful breach of the contract. The cost & consequence in such cases shall be on the sole account of the tenderer. Moreover, RSMML have full right to claim damages thereof in addition to the forfeiture of Bid Security.

6.0 BID SECURITY, TENDER DOCUMENT FEES & PROCESSING FEES:

- a) The tenderer shall deposit (interest free) a sum of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) as Bid Security in the form of Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Bank Pay Orders payable to RSMML, Udaipur.
- b) Further, tenderers shall deposit a sum Rs. 1,180/- towards tender document fees and Rs. 500/- towards processing fees by Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Bank Pay Orders only to the office of GGM(MM) within the specified date & time. The details of furnishing such financial instruments are elaborated in clause no. 1.0. Payments through Cash, Cheque or Bank Guarantee will not be accepted.

Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Bank Pay Orders for Tender Fees, Processing Fees and Bid Security should be submitted offline (personally/post/courier) to the office of GGM(MM) before scheduled date & time as mentioned in tender document. Scanned copies of Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque/ Bank Pay Orders should also be uploaded along with the online Bid. The tender document fees & processing fees are non-refundable.

c) The Bid Security shall be forfeited in case of :

- i) If tenderer unsolicited revises and/or modifies and/or withdraw &/or cancel/amend the offer at its own after submission of tender during the validity period.
- ii) If it is established that tenderer has submitted any wrong information/forged document along-with the tender or thereafter.
- iii) If the tenderer declines to accept contract/order placed by the Company subsequent to acceptance of his offer.
- iv) If the tenderer does not submit the security deposit cum performance guarantee.
- v) If the tenderer breaches any promising provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidder as detailed at Annexure –A.
- (d) The Bid Security furnished by the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded after finalization of tender / validity of the offer has expired. Bid Security of successful tenderer will be refunded after receipt of Security Deposit cum performance guarantee.
- (e) The Bid Security of a tenderer lying with the company in respect of other tenders awaiting approval or rejected or on account of contract completed will not be adjusted towards bid security against this tender, however, the bid security originally deposited may be taken into consideration in case tender is re-invited.

However, tender document fees and processing fees have to be furnished afresh incase of re-tender.

7.0 SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

- (i) The scope of supply will include delivery, Installation, Commissioning & Testing of pump by the supplier in accordance with the specifications, terms and conditions of the tender to our SBU-PC(RP), Jhamarkotra Mines. Supplier will depute their service engineer at the time of commissioning of the pumps at site on free of cost basis.
- (ii) The supplier shall be entirely responsible for the performance of the contract in all respects according to the intent and meaning of the specification data etc. Any approval which involved in the contract (weather with or without test carried out by the supplier or Company) shall not bind the Company and notwithstanding any approval or acceptance given by the Company it shall be lawful for the Company to reject the material on arrival at site if it is found after inspection that the stores supplied by the supplier are not in conformity with the contract in all respects.

8.0 CONSIGNEE:

Head & Incharge, SBU-PC (RP) or his authorized officer.
RSMM Ltd, Jhamarkotra, Distt & via- Udaipur

9.0 RSMML's RIGHT:

The Company reserves the following rights at its sole discretion without assigning any reason thereof:

- a) to reject any or all the tenders received.
- b) to accept a tender either for the total requirement or part thereof or to split the work in more than one tenderer & not to accept the lowest tenderer.
- c) to judge any tender on technical grounds for its acceptance based on RSMML technical requirement.
- d) to cancel the tender, postpone it for another date, change the venue of the receipt of the tender.
- e) to increase / decrease the quantity.

The decision of the Company in above regards shall be final and biding on the tenderer. As a result of such change the Company will not entertain any claim whatsoever.

10.0 RATES:

- i) The price should be quoted on-line in Indian Currency strictly in Price Bid (BOQ) Cover C on f.o.r. destination basis.
- ii) The quoted price shall be on F.O.R. destination basis inclusive of basic price, Taxes, Duties, Levies, Packing, Forwarding, Transportation, Insurance, any

other Delivery Charges etc. upto destination. The quoted price will remain firm and fixed till complete execution of contract.

iii) Tenderer (s) are requested to offer prices strictly in the BOQ uploaded on the site. They should first download the BOQ from the site on their system and after filling it, the same BOQ should be uploaded on the e-procurement portal.

11.0 PRICE VARIATION:

- i) The agreed price shall remain firm and fixed till the complete execution of the contract. Only variation on account of changes in Taxes & Duties by the Government which are within the delivery schedule & directly reflected on invoice will be considered on production of documentary proof provided that the variation take place within the scheduled delivery period.
- ii) Save and except as aforesaid, the tenderer shall not be entitled to raise any claim and/or demand and/or any dispute on account of escalation or raise or increase in the prices of any other item or element.

12.0 NO COMPENSATION FOR ALTERATION OF DELIVERY SCHEDULE OR SUSPENSION OF SUPPLIES:

If at any time before commencement of the supply if the Company, for any reason, whatsoever do not require the whole supply or part thereof as specified in the PO, shall give notice in writing of the same to the supplier and the supplier shall not be entitled for any compensation and/or damage of any kind whatsoever on account for loss or profit etc. nor the contractor be entitled to any claim for compensation for re-scheduling of delivery period.

13.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT CUM PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

- i) Towards the due, proper and faithful fulfillment of the obligations under the contract, supplier will furnish to RSMML, Security Deposit cum Performance Guarantee of 10% of estimated value of contract by way of Demand Draft or in the form of Bank Guarantee in the prescribed Performa from any Public Sector/ICICI/ HDFC/AXIS Bank (except SBI) having its branch at Udaipur within 21 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO. The security cum performance guarantee should be valid for a period of 6 month in excess of the warrantee/guarantee period + delivery period.
- ii) The BG shall liable to be invoked/ amount of SD is liable to be forfeited wholly or partly at the sole discretion of the Company, should the supplier either fails to execute the work within the stipulated period or fails to fulfill the agreed obligations or fails to settle in full it's dues to the Company.
- iii) The Company is empowered to recover from the S.D. any sum due and /or any other sum that may be fixed by the Company as being the amount or loss or losses or damages suffered by it due to un-satisfactorily performance or non fulfillment of any of the conditions of the tender/contract.

- iv) The Bank Guarantee/ S.D. shall remain in force and binding, notwithstanding, if any variation, alternation, modifications are made to the contract or any extension of the contract period is granted by RSMML.
- v) RSMML shall not pay any interest on the Security Deposit. The security Deposit shall be released on application by the Supplier after the expiry of guarantees and after discharge of all the supplier's obligations under the contract.
- vi) The said Security shall not in any way be construed as a limitation of the supplier's responsibility or liability pertaining to its obligations and guarantees under the contract and shall be without prejudice to any other remedies available to RSMML in terms of the contract and or as per the laws of the land.
- vii) Incase SD is being furnished in the form of Bank Guarantee, the BG should be furnished on the non-judicial stamp paper of the value equal to 0.25% (Zero Point Twenty Five Percent) of total Security Deposit amount subject to the maximum of Rs. 25000/- or as applicable at the time of submission of B.G.
- viii) Bank Guarantee/S.D. should be send to the office of GGM (MM), CO.

14.0 RELAXATION IN TENDER DOCUMENT FEES, BID SECURITY & SECURITY DEPOSIT CUM PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

- (A) Tenderers offering in capacity of micro, small and medium enterprises of the State Rajasthan, having acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum as mentioned in Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, issued by the competent authority facilitated, on furnishing of a self-attested copy of acknowledgement of Entrepreneurs Memorandum-II/Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum, following relaxations will be provided
 - i) Tender document fees will be taken @50% of the prescribed total value of Tender document fees.
 - ii) Bid Security will be taken @25% of the total value of Bid Security. In case of offering the quantity lesser than the tendered quantity, then they can submit proportionate amount of bid security in proportion to the quantity being offered with respect to the bid security amount for tender quantity.
 - iii) Security Deposit will be taken @ 1% of the total value of order.
- (B) In case of participation by Undertakings, Corporations, Autonomous Bodies which are controlled and managed by Govt., Govt. Undertakings and Companies of Union Govt. & Govt. of Rajasthan, they are exempted from deposition of Earnest Money.

Except above, no exemption in respect of Tender Document Fee, Bid Security & Security Deposit (Performance Security) will be given to any party on any grounds (except considered by management on the merit of the case) and their offer will be liable for rejection.

15.0 GUARANTEE/WARANTEE:

The tenderer shall warrant that the stores supplied under the contract/order will be new, unused and shall be free from all defects and faults in material & workmanship.

The pump will be consistent with the established, recognized or stipulated standards for materials of the type ordered and in full conformity with the specifications, drawings or samples, if any.

The supplier shall guarantee/warranty for the satisfactory performance of the pump in all respect as per scope of work for a period of 12 months from the date of installation or 18 months from the date of supply, whichever is earlier. This warranty shall survive inspection and acceptance of the goods.

In the event of any defect in material, design and workmanship during the aforesaid period is found due to faulty material, design or poor workmanship, the defective part/pump will be replaced / repaired by the supplier at site free of cost within 30 days of intimation of warranty claims. The tenderer will be required to stock spare parts to take care of warranty failures. The guarantee/composite warranty shall be submitted along with the bill. Tenderer will also replace the defective parts, if any, during the warranty period free of cost. The responsibility to collect the defective/ rejected material will lie with the supplier and the cost for such collection will have to be borne by the supplier.

16.0 EVALUATION OF TENDER:

The techno-commercial suitability of the offer would be ascertained on the basis of its technical acceptance and based on the documents furnished and/or information gathered by RSMML about the tenderer. The price bid (part-II of tender) of only techno-commercially acceptable tenderers will be opened. The decision of the company in this regard shall be final and binding.

The tenderer who has earlier been suspended or banned by the company shall not be eligible to participate in this tender during the currency of suspension/ban period.

17.0 DETERMINATION OF LOWEST BIDDER FOR EVALUATION PURPOSE:

The lowest tenderer will be determined on the basis of total landed cost for Supply, Installation, Commissioning & Testing of Pump at our Jhamarkotra Mines including the basic price, Freight, Insurance and any other delivery charges etc. up to destination except GST and giving effect of direct/indirect tax/duties/levies imposed by Govt. of Rajasthan /Central Govt.

In the event the company does not find the lowest quoted rate, acceptable to it, then the tender will be scrapped and may be re-tender, or company may take any other suitable action as deemed fit looking to the exigency of the work.

NEGOTIATIONS:-

- i) Negotiations may be conducted with the lowest tenderer only. In case of non-satisfactory achievement of rates from lowest tenderer, RSMML may choose to make a written counter offer to the lowest tenderer and if this is not accepted, RSMML may decide to reject and re-invite fresh tenders or to make the same counter-offer first to the second lowest tenderer, then to the third lowest tenderer and so on in the order of initial bidding, and work order be awarded to the tenderer who accepts the counter offer.
- ii) In the case, when the quotations given by the tenderer during negotiations is higher than the original quotation of the tenderer then the tenderer will be bound by the lower rate originally quoted by the tenderer.
- iii) In case of negotiations, representative of the tenderer attending negotiations must possess written authority from the tenderer to the effect that he is competent to modify/amend the submitted tender deviations and rates offered by them.

In the event the company does not find the lowest quoted rate, acceptable to it, then the tender will be scrapped and may be re-invited, or company may take any other suitable action as deemed fit looking to the exigency of the work.

18.0 WORK COMPLETION PERIOD:

The Tenderer should state the earliest possible work completion period for complete scope of work as per tender i.e. Supply, Installation, Commissioning & Testing of Vertical Turbine Pump with Motor Assembly at f.o.r. Jhamarkotra mines basis.

19.0 INSPECTION:

- RSMML shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the specification/data of each item at the Supplier's works &/or Consignee's end.
- ii) Final inspection shall be carried out at consignee's end after receipt of the material at site, which will be binding on both the parties.
- iii) In case of rejection of any supply, the same should be replaced by the tenderer at their cost, immediately within 30 days of intimation for rejection or within the specified delivery period. Tenderer will take rejected material back at their own risk, cost & transportation.

Provided further that if the performance in whole or in part is delayed by reasons of any such events for a period exceeding thirty days either party may at its option terminate the contract.

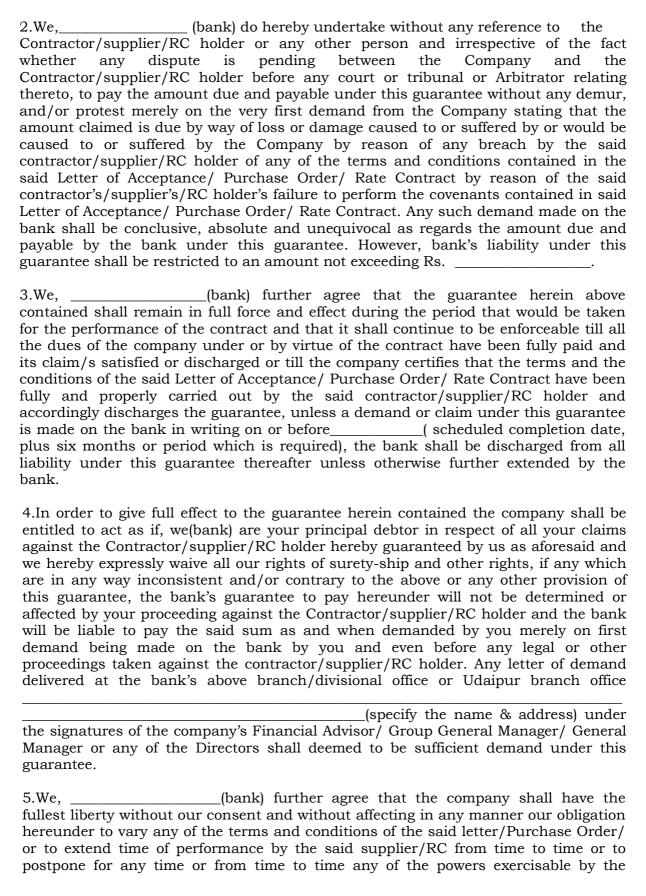

1. Filing an appeal

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules or the Guidelines issued thereunder, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in the procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a Procuring Entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial Bids, an appeal related to the matter of Financial Bids may be filed only by a Bidder whose Technical Bid is found to be acceptable.

- 2. The officer to whom an appeal is filed under para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.
- 3. If the officer designated under para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in para (2) or if the Bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to Second Appellate Authority specified in the Bidding Document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, as the case may be.

- d. Cancellation of a procurement process;

5. Form of Appeal

- c. Every appeal may be presented to First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, in person or through registered post or authorized representative.

6. Fee for filing appeal

- a. Fee for the first appeal shall be rupees two thousand five hundred and for second appeal shall be rupees ten thousand, which shall be non-refundable
- b. The fee shall be paid in the form of bank demand draft or bankers' cheque of a Scheduled Bank in India payable in the name of Appellate Authority concerned.

7. Procedure for disposal of appeal

- a. The First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, upon filing of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing.
- b. On the date fixed for hearing, the First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority , as the case may be, shall –
- i) Hear all the parties to appeal present before him; and
- (ii) Peruse or inspect documents, relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter.
- c. After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the Appellate Authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and provide the copy of order to the parties to appeal free of cost.

Annexure D: Additional Conditions of Contract

1. Correction of arithmetical errors

Provided that a Financial Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis:

- (i) if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Procuring Entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- (ii) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of sub totals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- (iii) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities

- (i) At the time of award of contract, the quantity of Goods, works or services originally specified in the Bidding Document may be increased or decreased by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the Bidding Document. It shall be without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions of the bid and the conditions of contract.
- (ii) If the Procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity in the Bidding Document due to change in circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the conditions of contract.
- (iii) In case of procurement of goods or services, additional quantity may be procured by placing a repeat order on the rates and conditions of the original order. However, the additional quantity shall not be more than 50% of the value of goods of the original contract and shall be within one month from the date of expiry of last supply. If the supplier fails to do so, Procuring Entity shall be free to arrange for the balance supply by limited bidding or otherwise and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the supplier.

3. Dividing quantities among more than one bidder at the time of award (In case of procurement of goods)

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the bidder, whose bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted.
